New Business: 1. Jim Plunket will be doing boat safety checks on Sunday June 6 from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM

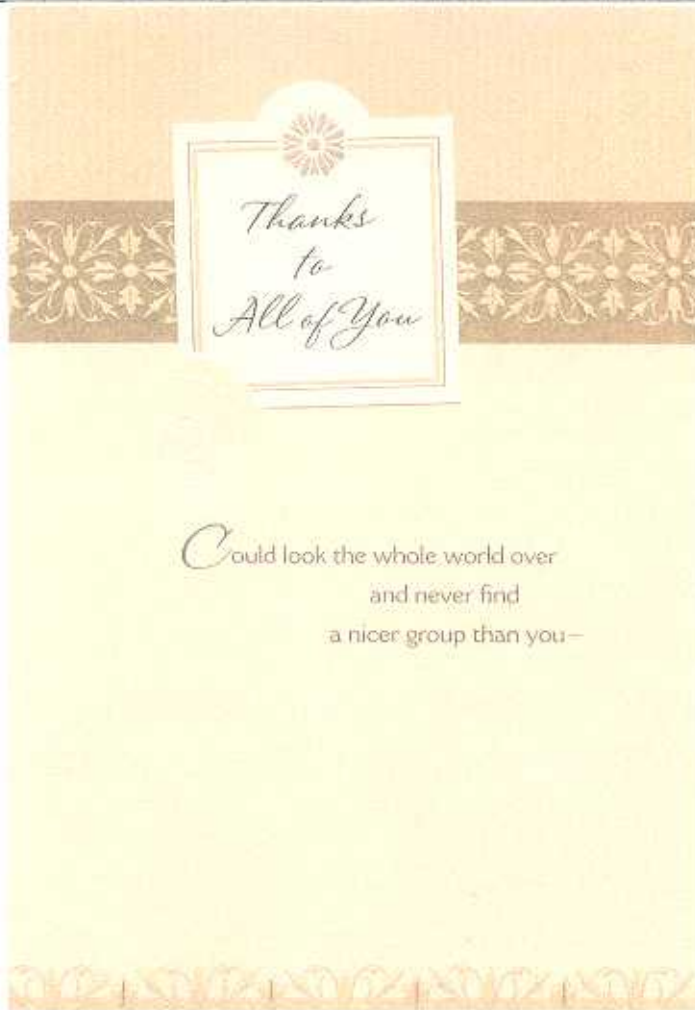
2. Fuzzy is talking to Starved Rock club on the sale of our Bubbler

3. Cherry Richardson suggested that we have a least 6 people sign up for each shift at the Steak Fry. Check the board for sign up sheets

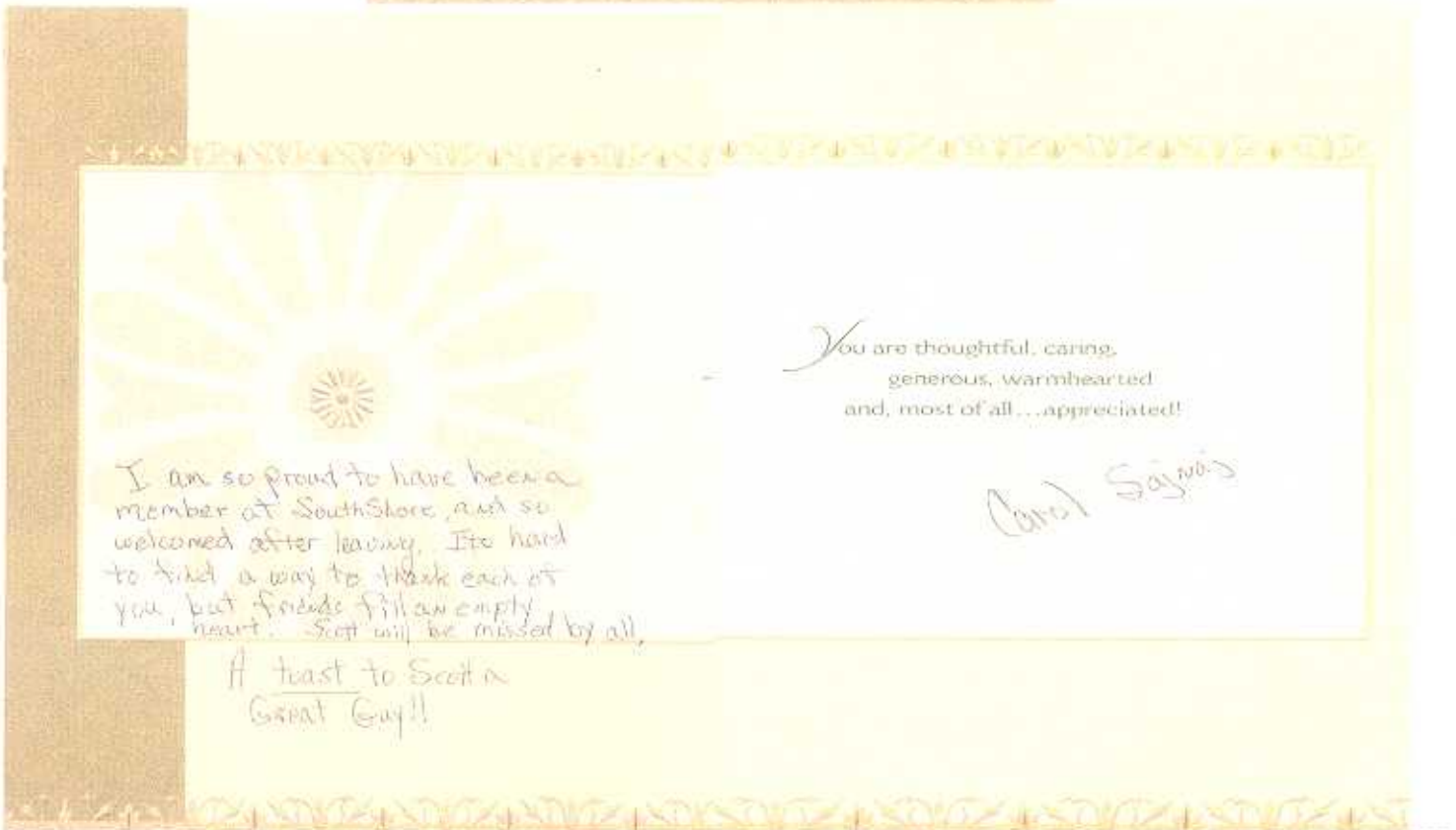
